Socrata Open Expenditures — Schemas

Introduction

Socrata's Open Expenditures allows you to present and visualize the transaction-level details of your ledger/checkbook, with specific detail around the vendors used by your organization. The interface of Open Expenditures is automatically generated from your data.

Open Expenditures requires one dataset to function and recommends a second one. Each is described below. You can think of each dataset as having all your data on a single tab in Microsoft Excel. The experience in Open Expenditures is only as good as your data. While some columns below are not strictly required, more data is always better than less.

The dataset described below has three categories of columns/fields:

- Required Fields: These fields are required by Open Expenditures to function.
- Recommended Fields: When these fields are provided, Open Expenditures can provide a more relevant experience for all
 users.
- **Optional Fields**: These fields are optional as they are useful for analysts accessing the information and may be used in future enhancements of the Open Expenditures product.

payment_method	Optional	Text	Identifies how payment was made (e.g. wire, check, p-card).

payment_check_num	Optional	Text	This is the check number.

This is an **optional** dataset that adds contextual detail on the vendor pages by joining to the Ledger dataset. Requires a common key with the Ledger dataset, either vendor_name or vendor_id.
